



Following his capture at Gettysburg, Lt. James B. Pool was taken to Johnson's Island in Ohio.






An excerpt from a list of Confederate POWs who made Soldier Art while at Johnson's Island. James B. Pool made a cross during his confinement.




In March 1965, James B. Pool was taken up the James River to Cox Landing where he was exchanged for Union prisoners.






Alexander County Courthouse, as it looked in 19th century.
