James M. Crumpler being
Duly sworn says, that he
belonged to Company A. 30th
Regiment N.C. Troops and that
Joseph Butler, the husband of
Isabella Butler, the applicant
for a pension, belonged to same
Company and Regiment.
That in May or June of the year
1864, Joseph Butler was wound-
ed in the left leg, and the
leg was amputated by Dr.
Briggs, Surgeon, of Virginia.
Afterwards said Joseph Butler
was carried to the Field Hospi-
tal near Spotsylvania C. A.
where he died.

James Crumpler further states
that he was present in person
when leg was amputated
and knows of his own knowl-
edge that said Butler died
from the effects of the wound.
